It is a monthly run of several thousand and we have an 8 day window to print, laminate, bind and send it out. But we are confident in delivering that and our customers are confident in us too."

He continues: "Its implementation was very smooth. In fact on the first day of training we produced a live job. Investing in new equipment is about effective and efficient utilisation. The BQ-280 gives us that. We had an idea of what the ROI would be but we are going to beat that with ease. The machine has been paying for itself from day one.

KEP Print Group produces litho print on a Roland R900XXL, R710P, R706, R205, and digital print on a Scitex FB7600, AGFA Jeti, 3020 Titan, HP Indigo and DGI-VE3204D. It specialises in POS and brochures with clients including Greggs, Citroen, Amtico, AGA and L'Oreal.

It is the final piece in a jigsaw puzzle that we started when we set up the business in 1989," states Managing Director Amanda Strong. The latest investment concludes a £100,000 spend.

"I have wanted to add laminating for a long time but I couldn't make the figures stack up," states Strong. "Then we increased our digital print output with the Xerox J75 18 months ago and saw a greater shift to short run litho jobs. Although we had a small laminator to cover small and digital runs we did not have in house lamination on the larger litho runs. This meant we were sending more lamination out which took time and added cost. I ran the figures again and this time they made sense."

"We are already able to offer lamination as an extra much more freely than we were before. This helps us create a more value added service which in turn makes our customers feel like they are getting more for their money. We can also promote the service more readily because we know we have full control of the process and timings - especially when so many jobs are now on demand. There are so many areas it impacts. It was such a good decision to buy. We are seeing a growing interest in targeted mail. Lamination is central to this and being able to keep control of all the elements inhouse will greatly enhance our service. We did a lot of research. The Foliant was a solid piece of kit, had a good reputation in the industry and the sales team filled us with confidence in what it could do and how it could help our business. It is easy to use and produces high quality results. We are very happy with it.

GENERAL COMMERCIAL WELSH OPERATION THE PRINT CO HAS ADDED IN-HOUSE PUR PERFECT BINDING TO ITS PORTFOLIO OF SERVICES FOLLOWING INVESTMENT IN A HORIZON BO-470 PERFECT BINDER AND HORIZON HT-30 AUTOMATIC BOOK TRIMMER.

We were looking to expand our digital operation and previously outsourced all our PUR binding," explains Chief Operating Officer Danny Lock.

"We have a very good relationship with our suppliers but it was time to bring the shorter runs in-house. Investing in the Horizon BQ-470 binder will mean we are able to offer a quick response to our customers' needs and enable a greater control over costs. We can be much more certain with critical timings. No matter how good our relationship was with our suppliers there was still inevitably a time delay. It is so easy to set up and run, enabling all shifts to complete jobs as and when they are needed."

"We considered the alternatives but there were a number of features on the Horizon we found important. One main reason was the safety factor of the glue application and setting. Because of turnaround times we are unable to wait to check the books so we needed an application process we could be sure of. We feel the Horizon gives us this. This is especially the case for short runs that need to be delivered quickly by bringing this work in house we have control of turnaround times, quality and costs."

"With the trimmer we can automatically trim PUR bound books to streamline the production and ensure a fast turnaround service by eliminating a bottle neck of guillotine work cutting PUR books after binding.
